36 **APPLICANT PRESENTED FOR BOARD REVIEW – Terry H. Clarke, D.P.M.**

38 Dr. Clarke was present.

40 Dr. Pearce provided an overview of Dr. Clarke's application. She stated that Dr. Clarke had
41 answered "Yes" to history question 1 on the Confidential and Exempt from Public Records
42 Disclosure.

49 **RECONSIDERATION OF DENIAL – Donna Faulkner**

3 Mr. Flury provided an overview of Ms. Faulkner request for Reconsideration of Denial of her
4 application. She stated that Ms. Faulkner had answered “Yes” to history questions 4a and the
5 applicant history question 1. According to 21 U.S.C., Section 846, the applicant is ineligible for
6 licensure. Therefore, the board is required to deny her licensure based on Chapter 456.0635, F.S.
7 The board denied her application at the November 16, 2012, meeting.

27 **small businesses and would not be likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to**
28 **any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within**
29 **one (1) year after the implementation of the rule. The motion was seconded and carried 4/0.**
